The grievance of the petitioner in the present writ petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent Nos.1 and 2 to amend/prepare the partition papers afresh in view of the order dated 18.09.2012 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.1 in ROR No.742 of 2010 and as per the compromise deed dated 09.07.2011 (Annexure P-2). In this regard, the applications dated 19.03.2014, 22.04.2013 and 24.07.2014 (Annexure P-4) were submitted to the respondent(s), but no action has been taken so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied, if the applications (Annexure P-4) served by the petitioner, are decided within time bound manner.

Without commenting upon the merits and demerits of the case,

respondent No.3 is directed to consider the applications (Annexure P-4) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order thereon.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is allowed with
aforementioned direction.
