At the very outset, learned counsel states that the date on page No.20 mentioned as 15.12.2016 is typing error and it should be 23.05.2017 and prays that she may be allowed to make the correction.

Allowed as prayed for.

By this petition the petitioner has challenged the order dated 24.05.2017 (Annexure P-2) with the allegation that he has been uprooted from Amritsar just to accommodate the respondent No.3. In this connection, he is stated to have moved a representation dated 22.03.2017 (Annexure P-4). Learned counsel states that at this stage she would be satisfied if a direction is given to the respondent No.1 to decide the said representation by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable

time.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.1 to decide the said representation of the petitioner by passing a speaking order thereon and till then not to enforce the order of transfer of the petitioner.

Copy of this order be given *dasti* to the learned counsel for the petitioner under the signatures of the Bench Secretary.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
