For the relief claimed in this petition the petitioners are stated to have issued a Legal Notice dated 23.03.2017 (Annexure P-8) and the learned counsel states that at this stage he would be satisfied if the same is decided by the respondent No.2 by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case the petitioners are found entitled to the relief claimed the same be also granted to them within the aforesaid period.

Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
