The petitioner has filed the present petition in the nature of Public Interest Litigation (PIL). The petitioner has not been able to show his credentials to file such a petition in terms of the provisions of the Maintainability of Public Interest Litigation Rules, 2010 ('Rules' – for short) as also the judgment of a Division Bench of this Court in Ajaib Singh and another v. State of Punjab and others, (2013-4) PLR 367 regarding which he was informed by the Registry that it was available on the High Court website.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition and file a fresh one by giving better particulars with respect to the credentials of the petitioner to file such a petition in accordance with the Rules and the judgment of this Court in Ajaib Singh's case (supra).
