1. Challenge in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for quashing the notice issued under Section 137 of the Punjab Municipal Act, 1976 (Annexure P-18) served on 3.5.2017 by the respondent-corporation vide which the petitioner has been asked to deposit a sum of ₹ 9,05,969/- as arrears of house tax of property/building No. XXXVII/9, (8-A), Model Town, Phagwara for the years 2010-11 to 2012-2013.

2. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition by granting liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed and comprehensive representation before the respondents raising all the pleas as have been taken in the present writ petition challenging Annexures P-18 and P-20. The said representation may be filed within two weeks from today. If such a representation is filed by the petitioner within two weeks from today, the same shall be decided

by passing a speaking order in accordance with law after affording an

opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within next one month.
