Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner having obtained 66% marks in the written test, he could not be below the cut off marks of the last selected candidate in the category of Scheduled Castes.

However, Mr.Kanwal Goyal, learned counsel for the respondent Commission, submits that the marks of the written test were not calculated as they were, but on a percentile basis, dividing the total marks by two and therefore, the petitioner would have obtained 33 marks in the written test and the remaining marks in the other criteria, totaling 45.32 marks, as already noticed in the last order.

The last candidate of the Scheduled Caste category having secured 54.84 marks, which is well above the marks obtained by the petitioner, nothing survives in this petition.

Dismissed.
