The petitioner has been ordered to be evicted from the restaurant complex situated in Sector-5, Panchkula. The eviction order has been passed by the Estate Officer, HUDA, Panchkula in purported exercise of its powers under Section 18 (2) of the Haryana Urban Development Authority Act, 1977. The aggrieved petitioner has filed an appeal before the Administrator HUDA, Panchkula, who vide order dated 25.05.2017, has granted him partial interim relief. Still aggrieved, the petitioner is before us.

[2] Since the Appellate Authority is seized of the matter, we do not deem it necessary to express any view on merits. The writ petition is accordingly disposed of with a direction to the Administrator HUDA,

Panchkula to decide petitioner's appeal expeditiously but not later than three

months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

[3] During interregnum, the petitioner shall be at liberty to seek further/additional interim relief.
