Affidavit of Gaurav Kaushal, IDES dated 29.4.2017 filed in
court is taken on record.

The petitioners have approached this court seeking a direction
to the respondents to conclude the process of acquisition of land, which has
been occupied by ammunition depot. Earlier CWP No. 4760 of 2013 was

filed, which was disposed of on 8.10.2013 directing Deputy Commissioner, SAS Nagar, (Mohali) to initiate the process for acquisition of land. The needful was not done.

In the affidavit filed today by Gaurav Kaushal, IDES, it has been stated that sanction has already been granted by the Ministry of Defence for acquisition of land. Communication dated 25.4.2017 has been sent to Deputy Commissioner, SAS Nagar, (Mohali) to initiate the process and conclude the same at the earliest. As per letter dated 28.4.2017 from Deputy Commissioner, SAS Nagar, (Mohali) the process will take about one year.

Considering the aforesaid stand taken by the respondents, the present petition is disposed of in terms of the stand taken in the affidavit filed today.
