Petitioner is seeking appointment as a Guest Teacher (Hindi) w.e.f. 16.01.2006 and wages apart from seeking setting aside of the appointment of private respondent No.5-Urmila Rani, who was appointed via back-door entry, after the cut-off date and therefore, this Court has been approached.

A period of more than a decade has gone by. Certain rights have accrued to the private respondent No.5. In matters pertaining to service jurisprudence, delay is an aspect which is to be kept in mind. Accordingly, keeping in view the fact that private-respondent No.5 had been appointed on 16.01.2006, against which, the petitioner did not raise any grievance and as such, he is not entitled, at this stage, to seek the relief as prayed for, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

Accordingly, in view of the above, the present writ petition stands dismissed in limine, on the ground of limitation.
