Learned counsel for the respondent(s) has produced the office order dated 05.06.2017, whereby the sanction had been accorded to appoint the petitioner/M/s Jagjiwan Pal Singh and Company, as labour handling contractor for handling of FCI Stocks (godown operations only) in FCI guarantee godowns at SWH, Kurukshetra-I & II @ 171% above SOR rates after negotiation held on 05.06.2017. The rate has been accepted for a period of two years from the date of joining the work i.e. from 07.06.2017 to 06.06.2019 and further, the Corporation had reserved the right to extend it further for one year subject to the condition that the Contractor will execute an agreement in the prescribed form as given in the tender form and

deposit the security amounting to ₹ 5,00,000/- before the start of work.

Copy of the same is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions. Office to tag the same at appropriate place.

2. It was submitted that in view thereof, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. However, learned counsel for the petitioner does not controvert the aforementioned fact.

4. Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.
