AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court, praying for issuing a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to grant the benefit of promotional increments to him in view of the circular dated 23.04.1990 (Annexure P-1) and also keeping in view the fact that similar relief has been granted by this Court in Civil Writ Petition No.20139 of 2015 (Chiman Singh Vs. Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd. and others) vide order dated 29.02.2016 (Annexure P-3). Counsel contends that the petitioner in that writ petition has already been granted the benefit, as has been claimed by the petitioner in the present writ petition. A representation dated 03.05.2017 (Annexure P-4) has also been submitted to the Senior Executive Engineer, Operation Division, PSPCL, Anandpur Sahib. Counsel contends that liberty may be granted to the petitioner to file a supplementary detailed representation, putting forth his claim while relying upon the instructions as well as

judgement passed by this Court in support of his claim, which shall be filed by the petitioner within a period of two weeks and the same may be directed to be considered and decided within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner and without going into the merit of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with an observation that in case the petitioner submits a detailed representation within the time as sought for by the petitioner, the same shall be considered and decided by the respondents by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of said representation.

In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to him, in accordance with law, within a further period of three weeks.

In case the claim of the petitioner is not to be accepted, then a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
