The petitioner joined respondent-department on 22.3.1976 as a Medical Officer and resigned from service on 20.3.1990 i.e. after completing 14 years of service. Now, she has filed the present writ petition, stating that she is entitled to pension.

I am of the view that after 27 years of resignation from service, it is not a fit case where the writ jurisdiction should be exercised. Let the petitioner establish her claim by filing civil suit before the civil court. Therefore, the petitioner is relegated to avail remedy before the civil court.

In view of the matter, the present writ petition is disposed of.
