The petitioners are licensees to whom permission has been granted to sell raw-fish in the Fish Market at Amritsar. It is averred that old Fish Market has been decided to be shifted and the new Fish Market has been notified. However, instead of allotting shops in the new Fish Market to the old licensees in accordance with the provisions of Punjab State Agricultural Marketing Board (Sale and Transfer of Plots), Rules 1999, the Board decided to sell the plots by way of open auction. The petitioners also participated in the auction held on 30.08.2016 and being the highest bidders, have been allotted shop-sites. The petitioners now seek a direction that instead of allotting the said shops at the auctioned price, the authorities be directed to convert the allotment at the concessional rate and on preferential basis as per the 1999 Rules.

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and gone through the records.

Keeping in view the fact that such a claim has already been raised by the petitioners before the authorities vide representation dated

17.04.2017 (P-7), the instant writ petition is disposed of without expressing any views on merits, with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the above-mentioned claim of the petitioners by way of a reasoned order within a period of two months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
