Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is aggrieved on account of the fact that he has not been permitted to join on deputation with respondent No.5.

The impugned order dated 15.05.2017 (Annexure P12) would go on to show that the practical training had already been completed. It is not disputed that the petitioner was appointed on 05.05.2016 (Annexure P4) by respondent No.1A, could not join in the said batch, as he had fallen sick and contacted the disease of jaundice. In such circumstances, it is always open to the petitioner to approach the principal employer for the necessary relief.

Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioner does not press the present writ petition and prays for liberty to approach the competent authorities for the necessary relief.

Ordered accordingly.
