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Through the instant writ petition, petitioner seeks a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to ensure that the petitioner can carry out the execution of the handling contract allotted to him vide allotment letter dated 24.4.2017 Annexure P-1 by respondent No. 4 without any hindrance by private respondents. In this context, the petitioner has submitted a representation Annexure P-2 dated 31.5.2017 addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, referring to vernacular appended with the petition.

Notice to Advocate General Punjab.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Anu Pal, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice. Copy given.

In the interest of justice, present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur to consider the grievance of the petitioner and to ensure the maintenance of law and order, while considering the grievance regarding obstruction as alleged, within a period of two months after the receipt of the

certified copy of this order. In case of any threat, it will be open to the petitioner to approach the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur. It is expected that in the said eventuality, it will be fairly looked into in accordance with law.
