On the last date of hearing, following order was passed:-

“Challenge in the present petition is to order passed by District Magistrate, Union Territory, Chandigarh directing eviction of the petitioner from the premises in question. While issuing notice of motion, this court granted status quo with regard to possession subject to deposit of Rs.75,000/- with the District Magistrate, U.T. Chandigarh within a period of one week in lieu of maintenance, mesne profits and use and occupation of the property. Admittedly, the amount of Rs. 75,000/- has not been deposited by the petitioners.

Under the circumstances, interim order, which was conditional in nature, is hereby vacated. Learned counsel appearing for the U.T. Chandigarh may apprise the court whether the direction given by District Magistrate has been complied with and possession of the premises restored to respondents no. 1 & 2.

Adjourned to 16.11.2017.”

As the petitioners have failed to comply with order dated 2.6.2017, the petition is hereby dismissed for non-prosecution. The Deputy Commissioner, Chandigarh would be at liberty to ensure compliance of the direction given in order dated 20.04.2017 forthwith.
