Pursuant to the order dated 02.06.2017, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to place on record the orders of the Government passed from time to time, pertaining to pay-scales of different categories of employees as Annexures P-11 to P-13. He also seeks to place on record an undated application stated to have been made to the pay anomalies committee, as Annexure P-14.

He further seeks to place on record as Annexure P-15, the instructions of the Chief Secretary to the Government of Haryana, abolishing the distinction between Class A and Class B Officers in the State of Haryana, the said instructions being dated 02.03.1982.

A pay matrix schedule is also sought to be placed on record as Annexure P-16.

The application is allowed and the aforesaid documents are taken on record, as also is the policy, the application made under the RTI

Act, as Annexures P-10 to P-16, with the accompanying petition.

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Without making any comment on the merits of the contentions raised in the petition, with regard to grant of pay-scales to the petitioners on par with Superintendents in other departments of the State of Haryana, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents to take a decision on the representation, Annexure P-8, stated to have been made by the petitioners. If the representation needs to be referred to the pay anomalies committee, the competent authority shall do so, with the final decision to be taken thereon within a period of 6 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
