Petitioner has impugned award dated 05.08.2015, Annexure P-1, passed by Permanent Lok Adalat, Punjab, Utility Services, Gurugram. Operative part thereof reads under:-

“Respondent No.1 is, therefore, directed to refund an amount of Rs.21,71,760/- to the applicant with interest @ 9% per annum with effect from 22.10.2009, when the last payment was made by the applicant to the respondent, till the date of actual payment. The application is disposed of accordingly. File be consigned to record room.”

At the outset, Mr. Saini, learned counsel appearing for the respondents submits that, in case, the petitioner approach them, and supplies necessary information aforesaid, order shall be complied with.

This court is not inclined to enhance the interest as prayed for in the petition. This prayer is, thus, declined.

It is, however, made clear that, in case, petitioner supplies necessary information to the respondents within one month from today, needful shall be done by the Forum within six weeks thereafter.
