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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the payment of gratuity was paid to the petitioners in the year 2016, as per Annexure-P-1. However, these were paid with delay and interest on the same has not been paid. The petitioners have already served a legal notice dated 23.03.2017 (Annexure-P-3) upon respondents, but to no avail. The short prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners at this stage is that respondents may be directed to decide the legal notice of the petitioners dated 23.03.2017 (Annexure-P-3) in a time bound manner.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the opposite party, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the legal notice of the petitioners dated 22.03.2017 (Annexure-P-3), within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
