Through, instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to fix his pay @ Rs.5300/- instead of Rs. 5150/- w.e.f. 01.01.1996 at par with his junior along with all consequential benefits and arrears.

2. A glance at the reply filed by the State transpires that after considering the case of the petitioner, the respondent has already refixed the pay of the petitioner vide order dated 08.09.2017 whereby stepping up his pay equal to his junior Sh. Pritam Singh, Electrician in the pay scale of Rs.5300/- instead of Rs.5150/- w.e.f. 01.01.1996 as claimed by the petitioner.

3. After passing of the aforesaid order, the instant petition has rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

4. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved of the order dated 08.09.2017 (Annexure R-1), passed by General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Chandigarh, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedies available to him.
