Pleadings on record would indicate that vide order dated 30.09.2014 (Annexure P-4), petitioner while working as a Warder under the Punjab Jails Department along with another delinquent was imposed the major penalty of dismissal from service. Counsel apprises the Court that subsequently even the appeal preferred by the petitioner against the order of dismissal has been declined vide order dated 08.08.2017 passed by the Additional Director General of Police (Jails), Punjab.

Strangely, in the instant petition, even though, there is a prayer for issuance of a writ of mandamus to reinstate the petitioner in service, yet there is no challenge laid to the order of dismissal dated 30.09.2014 (Annexure P-4). Neither is the order of the Appellate Authority dated 08.08.2017 under challenge.

Confronted with such a situation, counsel prays for withdrawal of the petition with liberty to file a petition by making the necessary changes and by furnishing better particulars.

Prayer is allowed.

Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed
for.

Pending application, if any, shall also stands disposed of.
