By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to accord approval to amendment in Rule 1.3 of the Haryana State Cooperative Apex Bank Employees Staff Welfare Funds Rules, 1992 which stipulates for increasing allocation of fund out of annual profit from the Bank from 2% or Rs.15 lacs to 3% or Rs.50 lacs, which ever is less with further direction to respondent-Bank to release the medical allowance and medical reimbursement bills of the petitioners, including the pending bills.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though a legal notice dated March 30, 2017 (Annexure P-1) served upon the respondents and in response to the notice reply dated May 15, 2017 has also

been filed by the Managing Director, Haryana State Cooperative Apex Bank Ltd. but still concerned authorities i.e. respondents No.2 and 3 are sitting over the matter and has not taken a final decision in the matter.

At this stage, he feels satisfied, in case respondent No.2 is directed to enquire into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their legal notice dated March 30, 2017 (Annexure P-1) and to take an appropriate action within some reasonable period.

Thus, in view of the submission as well as considering the grouse ventilated in the petition, instant petition is disposed of with a directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their legal notice dated March 30, 2017 (Annexure P-1) and to appropriate decision within a period of one month from the date of certified copy of this order. However, in case the petitioners still feel aggrieved, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
