Present petition is directed against the order passed by Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Services), Yamuna Nagar. Applicant approached the forum with the grouse that high transmission lines and poles had been installed in his land without his consent. No compensation whatsoever had been paid to him. Even the poplar trees existing in the land were removed without his consent. Admittedly, the forum made an effort for conciliation. Same having failed, it directed that compensation of Rs.40,000/- be granted to the applicant. This court does not find any ground to interfere in the writ jurisdiction. Petition is thus without any merit and is hereby dismissed.
