By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated February 03, 2017 (Annexure P-10) whereby, the claim of the petitioner for fixation of pay after granting proficiency step up after 8/9/14 years of service on completion of 8 years of service from July 17, 2005 has been illegally rejected by considering instructions dated January 10, 2000 (Annexure P-2) instead of instructions dated July 21, 1997 (Annexure P-1) with further prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to revise the retiral benefits of the petitioner.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a legal notice dated August 24, 2016 (Annexure P-9) has been served upon the

respondents but till date no action has been taken. He further submits that in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated August 24, 2016 of the petitioner in view of instructions issued by the State of Haryana time to time, especially contained in Annexures P-1 to P-3 within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated August 24, 2016 (Annexure P-9) and to decide the same in view of instructions contained in Annexures P-1 to P-3, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and that too, by affording personal hearing to the petitioner.

However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
