This petition is directed against the order dated 10.01.2017 passed by the Financial Commissioner, Punjab, order dated 04.08.2016 passed by Commissioner, Ferozepur Division, Ferozepur and order dated 24.03.2015 passed by the Collector, Moga as well as the order dated 26.5.2014 passed by the Assistant Collector, 2nd Grade, Moga on the ground that it is in utter disregard and in violation of the Civil Court decree dated 24.01.2013 in which it has been directed that the partition cannot be sought in the absence of two sisters of the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the order of the Commissioner, Ferozepur dated 04.08.2016, am of the opinion that there is no merit in the petition because it is recorded in the order that the sisters of the petitioner had filed an application that they do not claim any share in the land which is previously owned by their father Malkiat Singh. There is hardly any substance in the petition and the same is hereby dismissed.
