By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to protect the pay scales of the petitioners as on 01.01.1996 alongwith all consequential relief as has been granted to other Junior Assistants in terms of decision of this Court in CWP No. 22422 of 2010 titled **Anil Kumar & others v. State of Punjab and others;** decided on 16.05.2012 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioners has contended that the petitioners have already served a legal notice dated April 17, 2017 (Annexure P-5) but till date no action has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and decide the legal notice dated April 17, 2017 (Annexure P-5) within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents look

into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their legal notice dated April 17, 2017 (Annexure P-5) and to decide the same in view of judgments reflected in the notice, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, in case the petitioners still feel aggrieved, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
