Through the instant Civil Writ Petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ certiorari to quash office Order No.76/ES-I dated April 03, 2013 (Annexure P-11), letter No.167-AC Pen-09/5202/AC dated 09.07.2013 (Annexure P-14) passed by respondent No.2 and directing the respondents to restore the promotional increment and last pay drawn during service and to restore pension of the petitioner as was fixed originally by Accountant General (A&E) Haryana @ Rs.14,670/- per month plus DA payable and also to refund the full amount recovered from the pension.

2. But at the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.4 to decide the representation dated February 05, 2015 (Annexure P-24) made by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

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3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that a large number of representations were made including one dated February 05, 2015 (Annexure P-24). The said representation was sent by the Principal Secretary to Government of Haryana, Finance Department along with noting to the Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, PWD (B&R) Branch for further necessary action vide letter dated March 10, 2015. Even though a period of more than two years has elapsed, no final decision has been taken by the concerned authorities till date.

4. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Additional Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Finance Department, Haryana, Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated February 05, 2015 (Annexure P-24) which was received in his office on March 21, 2015, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. He is further asked to take a disciplinary action against the official concerned who is responsible for putting up the matter as well as causing delay in it.
