By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents for awarding interest @ 12% per annum on account of delayed payment of family pension, gratuity and retiral benefits of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner has already submitted a representation March 17, 2017 (Annexure P-5) but till date no action has been taken on the said representation. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the representation dated March 17, 2017 (Annexure P-5) within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated March 17, 2017 (Annexure P-5) and to decide the same, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, in case the petitioner still feels aggrieved, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
