The grievance of the petitioners is that though they have always been ready and willing to pay the market price of the land where they have constructed their houses, however, instead of assessing and communicating such market value in terms of the order dated 21.04.1987 passed by the erstwhile Appellate Authority, the Gram Panchayat, due to party faction, has obtained a fresh eviction order dated 20.02.2017 against which the petitioners have filed appeal but their stay application is not being decided.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and considering the contentious issues raised by them before the Appellate Authority but without expressing any views on merits, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction that till the appeal is decided by respondent No.2, dispossession of the petitioners shall remain stayed and both the parties are directed to maintain *status-quo* re: demolition and further construction at the site
