1. By virtue of instant writ petition preferred under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus/direction or certiorari for quashing office order No.169 dated May 31, 2017 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.2 whereby the petitioner has been transferred from Distribution Sub Division, Nagoke, D.S. Rayya Division Beas under Distribution Circle, Tarn Taran to Kotli Surat Malli, Division Sub-Urban, Batala under circle Guraspur.

2. At the very outset of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner would be satisfied in case instant petition is treated as a representation and be sent to respondent No.2 – Deputy Chief Engineer/Personnel/Zone-T, Punjab State Power Corporation Limited, Patiala, to decide the grouse raised in it within a specified period.

The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 – Deputy Chief Engineer/Personnel/Zone-T, Punjab State Power Corporation Limited, Patiala, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in this writ petition, which has been treated as a representation on his behalf and take an appropriate decision in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this judgment.
