Petitioner-Corporation has impugned the orders passed by the authorities under the Public Premises Act. During the course of hearing, it has been stated on behalf of respondent No.1 that a compromise has been effected between the parties. It is further contended that order passed under the Act is unsustainable. Even otherwise, this court feels that order passed by the authority is non-speaking in nature. Thus impugned order passed by the appellate authorities is hereby set-aside. Case is remitted to the same authority for decision afresh after considering all the facts and circumstances of the case.
