The dispute pertains to demarcation of passage which abuts the land of the petitioners. While the Gram Panchayat alleges that the petitioners have encroached upon the passage, they are denying such allegation. The petitioners claim that should there be demarcation of the passage and their private land, it will stand establish that they have not encroached upon the passage.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners, we are of the considered view that such a plea can be taken by the petitioners by way of an appropriate application before the Prescribed Authority under the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887, where they can seek demarcation of their land as well as the passage. It is directed that if any such petition is filed by the petitioners, the same shall be decided in accordance with law preferably within four months from the date of its submission.

Ordered accordingly.
