Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the material which is adverse and proposed to be used by the respondents in taking disciplinary action for suspension/cancellation of the LPG distributorship has not been provided to him, even though he had made request in this regard.

The impugned order shows that the respondents have sought to proceed against the petitioner by assuming that he does not have anything to say as he did not submit his reply to the notice.

Be that as it may, without entering into the controversy whether respondents are wrong in this regard or the petitioner defaulted, it would be in the interest of justice, if the petitioner is confronted with the material sought to be used against him, which the respondents shall supply to him within a period of two weeks from today. Thereafter, the petitioner will submit his reply within two weeks from the date of receipt of the material. It is made clear that no further indulgence shall be granted to the petitioner in

this regard. Thereafter, the respondents shall afford an opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner and determine the controversy.

Disposed of in above terms.

Till the time final decision is taken as per the manner indicated above, the petitioner shall be permitted to operate the LPG distributorship.
