Vide public notice dated 09.07.2012, applications were invited for recruitment to 5078 posts of Rural Associate Teachers (Master Cadre) in the State of Punjab.

The instant petition has been preferred in the year 2017 raising challenge to one of the stipulations in the advertisement dated 09.07.2012 i.e. last cut of date in such public notice for receipt of applications. Basis of challenge is that the respondent-State had failed to conduct the Teachers Eligibility Test (TET) during the year 2012.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length, this Court finds that the instant petition and the prayer raised therein is wholly misconceived.

Learned counsel would concede that the process of selection initiated in the light of public notice dated 09.07.2012 already stands concluded and the appointments to the post in questions have already been effected. It will be too late in the day for this Court to entertain a challenge to one of the conditions contained in a public notice and in which the

selection process that followed already stands concluded.

Writ petition is dismissed.
