Learned counsel for the petitioners restricts his prayer to coercive proceeding not being taken against the petitioners for stay of the possession of the auctioned property, firstly on the ground that the petitioners are neither the borrowers nor the guarantors for the land in question and secondly, he submits that though he has filed an appeal against the impugned order (Annexure P-5), before the learned Debt Recovery Appellate Tribunal, Delhi, the Tribunal is not sitting on account of vacations, till 21.06.2017.

Without making any comment on the actual merits raised in the petition, we consider it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction that till the matter is taken up for hearing before the learned Debt Recovery Appellate Tribunal, the operation of the impugned order shall

remain stayed, provided that the matter is pursued by the petitioner before the Tribunal on 21.06.2017 itself and therefore, the interim order passed today by this Court shall continue to operate till 23.06.2017, unless the Tribunal takes up the matter on merit before that date.
