Petitioner has challenged order dated 25.01.2017 (Annexure P-10), passed by the Vice Chancellor, whereby his election petition has been rejected.

Stand of the respondent University is that election petition can be decided only by the Chancellor in view of the provision contained in Punjab University Act. He (on instructions from Surjit Singh Thakur, Office of Registrar, Colleges, who is present in court) submits that communication has already been sent to the concerned office and matter shall be further pursued. Necessary record shall be furnished to the office of the Chancellor.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary. Petition is hereby disposed of. Needless to observe that in case there is any fresh cause of action arises, petitioner shall be at liberty to avail appropriate remedy.
