Written statement dated 18.8.2017 filed by Rajesh Chaudhary, Executive Officer, Improvement Trust, Phagwara, on behalf of respondent nos. 2 and 4, in Court today, is taken on record.

The petitioners approached this Court with a grievance that before acquisition of the land in question is complete, they be not dispossessed forcibly as only notification under Section 36 of the Punjab Town Improvement Act, 1922 has been issued. The objections have been invited. The petitioners have already filed objections. Before decision thereof, the apprehension is that the petitioners may be evicted from the land in question.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent nos. 2, 4 and 5 submitted that the objections filed by the petitioners have been considered and report has been sent to the Government. He further submitted that there is no proposal to evict the petitioners forcibly from the land in dispute until the process of acquisition is complete.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that in view of the aforesaid stand taken by learned counsel for respondent nos. 2, 4 and 5, the petition may be disposed of in terms thereof.

Ordered accordingly.
