Affidavit of Sh. Subhash Chander Sihag, Estate Officer, HUDA, Ambala, filed in Court today, which is taken on record, copy thereof has been supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions from Sh. Subhash Sihag, Estate Officer, Ambala, states that there are 65 plots lying vacant, out of which, as per the policy, the requisite number of plots would be identified and an advertisement will be issued within a period of two weeks calling the claims/applications from the oustees. After finalization of the claims of the oustees, the draw of lots will be held within a further period of six weeks from the date of issuance of the advertisement. He further states that the petitioner, if is an oustee, can also put-forth his claim in pursuance to the advertisement, which shall be considered and appropriate decision taken thereon.

In view of above statement of learned counsel for the respondent, which has been made by him on instructions from Subhash Chander Sihag, Estate Officer, the present petition has been rendered infructuous which is disposed of accordingly.

The Estate Officer, HUDA shall be bound by his statement as given by the counsel.

The interim order dated 14.06.2017 stands vacated.
