Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has taken admission in LLB (evening classes) in Gurugram after due permission granted to him for that purpose, but he has thereafter been transferred to Nuh, District Mewat. He is stated to have made a representation against his transfer.

He submits that there is a post lying vacant in Gurugram even now. He further submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner sympathetically.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.1 to take a decision on the representation of the petitioner and in the aforesaid circumstances, to consider the case of the petitioner

sympathetically, within a period of 1 month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
