The petitioner's grievance is against the order dated 07.06.2017 (P-6) whereby Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat of his village has asked him to remove the encroachment from Street No.466 within one week, failing which police help will be sought to remove the illegal possession.

The above-stated order has been passed admittedly in deference to the order dated 01.06.2017 passed by this Court in COCP No.2057 of 2016 whereby one more opportunity has been granted to the authorities to comply with the order dated 02.03.2005 re: removal of encroachments and to purge the contempt.

The case of the petitioner is that the Gram Panchayat has filed a petition under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961, as applicable to the State of Haryana, for his eviction from the alleged encroached part of public street and he has already put in contest in such eviction petition.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, it appears to us

directions issued on judicial side in the pending contempt proceedings, the appropriate recourse for the petitioner is to seek his impleadment in the contempt petition and plead his case before the learned Contempt Judge.

Ordered accordingly.

The petitioner shall be at liberty to move an appropriate application before the Contempt Court within one week.

Meanwhile, *status-quo* re: further demolition be maintained for one week.
