The petitioner who is working as a Driver is aggrieved against his transfer from Jhajjar to Gurugram vide order dated 31.5.2017 (Annexure P/2) which has been done on the ground that he is longer stayee by respondent no.3.

It is not disputed that the petitioner was transferred to Jhajjar on 27.8.2015 and he has been there for a period of approximately one year and nine months. He has already been made a request for cancelling his transfer to respondent no.2 vide representation dated 7.6.2017 (Annexure P/5) which is yet to be acted upon.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Shruti Jain Goyal, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Copies of the writ petition have been supplied to her.

Keeping in view the fact that the transfer orders are not liable to be interfered with except in compelling circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that the petitioner's grievance can be duly redressed by respondent to whom the representation has already been made.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2

to take into consideration the said representation dated 7.6.2017 (Annexure P/5) and pass an appropriate order within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case any adverse order is to be passed then a reasoned order be passed by the said respondent and copy thereof be supplied to the petitioner.

The present writ petition is disposed off with the aforesaid directions.
