The petitioners have filed this writ petition seeking direction to quash the impugned letters dated 06.06.2017 (Annexure P-5 and P-6). The aforesaid letters have been issued by the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Sonipat. Therein, a reference has been made of decision dated 03.03.2017 in CWP-4437-2017, where this Court had directed that an opportunity be given to the petitioners before passing an eviction order. Vide the impugned letters, the petitioners have been directed to appear before the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Sonipat, to plead their case alongwith documents at 03.00 p.m on 19.06.2017 and 20.06.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners were not party in the said petition mentioned in the impugned letters. He further states that the petitioners have filed a civil suit for permanent injunction for restraining the Municipal Corporation from dispossessing the petitioners and from demolishing the premises. In the said suit the status quo order has been issued.

In my view, there is no merit in the petition. The impugned notices are only show-cause-notices calling upon the petitioners to appear before the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Sonipat alongwith related documents. No order for eviction or demolition has been passed against the petitioners. It would be open to the petitioners to appear before the authorities to plead that orders dated 03.03.2017 in CWP-4437-2017, is not applicable in case of the petitioners and the petitioners are protected by status quo passed by the Civil Court.

No ground is made out for interference.

The petition is disposed of.
