Main Case

Petitioner who was serving as a Peon had challenged in

the writ petition order dated 20.06.2017 (Annexure P-3) whereby he had been transferred from State Consumer Commission, Punjab, Chandigarh to District Forum, Amritsar.

Counsel representing the petitioner submits that after filing of the writ petition, a subsequent development has taken place in terms of issuance of memo dated 14.08.2017 (appended as Annexure P-1) along with the written statement and as per which the petitioner has been offered the post of Peon by way of transfer in the Punjab Civil Secretariat.

Counsel states that in the light of such development, nothing would survive in the writ petition and prays for withdrawal of the same.

Writ petition is dismissed as not pressed.
