The present petitioners are the members of the Hisar Animal Husbandary Cooperative House Building Society Limited who have been suspended by the Deputy Registrar, Hisar exercising his powers under Section 35(2) of the Haryana Co-operative Societies Act, 1984 (for short, 'the Act')

Although the petitioner has mentioned in para 12 of the writ petition that there is no remedy of appeal/ revision under the Act yet during the course of hearing, learned counsel has been very fair to concede that the impugned order is revisable in terms of Section 115 of the Act. In view thereof, the writ petition is not maintainable as alternate remedy under the Statute is available to the petitioners which may be availed by them for the purpose of redressal of the grievance.

Consequently, the present petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to file the revision petition against the impugned order, if so, advised.
