Rajan Gupta, J.

Petitioner has prayed for a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct respondents to allow the petitioners to work as labourers at the Railhead Barnala as they have experience in this line.

It appears, Food Corporation of India hands over work of loading/unloading to various contractors. They in turn engage labour for carrying out the work. Contention of the petitioners is that they are not being engaged despite the fact that they are ready to work at lower rates, which would be beneficial to the Corporation.

I find no merit in this plea. It is inexplicable why present writ petition has been filed, which does not disclose violation of any constitutional or legal right. Same is wholly conceived. The writ petition is hereby dismissed.
