A representation dated 08.01.2016 is said to have been submitted by the petitioners to respondent No.2.

expressing any views on merits of their claim, the writ petition is disposed

of with a direction to respondent Nos.2 and 4 to verify the facts and decide the petitiones' above-mentioned claim by way of a reasoned order, within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
