Through the instant Civil Writ Petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of direction especially in the nature of mandamus to the respondents to grant increments, seniority and pension to the petitioner for the period spent in Military Service and consequential benefits thereof and further directing the respondents to grant the benefit of Military Service rendered by the petitioner during the period of 03.12.1971 to 25.03.1977 in 2nd National Emergency for adding towards pension with the direction to respondent to re-fix the pay of the petitioner for the purpose of revision of pension and arrears along with interest at the rate of 12% per annum.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case the concerned authorities has been directed to consider the legal notice and to take a final decision on merits.

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3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated April 17, 2017 (Annexure P-5) and to take an appropriate decision thereon by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
