By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the retirement-cum-service benefits of the petitioners, along with interest for delayed period.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.4 to decide the representation dated March 06, 2017 (Annexure P-4) within a stipulated period.

Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated March 06, 2017 (Annexure P-4) and to decide the same within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this

order. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved of any order passed by the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
