SURYA KANT, J. (Oral)

(1) The grievance of the petitioners in this writ petition is against the communication dated 06.04.2015 sent by the Estate Officer, HUDA Jagadhari asking them to submit the affidavits of 'no objection' of their other co-sharers for the purpose of allotment of plot under the oustees quota.

(2) Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that such an affidavit cannot be asked by the Estate Officer as each co-sharer is entitled for allotment of plot in view of the decision dated 04.04.2016 of this Court rendered in **Santosh Kumari vs. State of Haryana & Ors. (CWP No.6684 of 2014)** and other connected cases.

(3) In this view of the matter, we dispose of this writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to file their objection(s) against the above-mentioned notice dated 06.04.2015 and the Estate Officer, HUDA, Jagadhari is directed to determine the petitioners' claim afresh in the light of the decision of this Court in **Santosh Kumari**.

(4) Let appropriate decision be taken by the Estate Officer within **three months** from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
