By virtue of instant civil writ petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the ex-gratia payment, gratuity, leave encashment, provident fund and dearness allowance installments.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that Mohan Lal s/o Jiwan Parkash was working as Safai Sewak in the office of respondent No.4 and he expired during the service on 17.12.2012 but till today a period of more than 4 years have been elapsed, the service benefits have not been released to the petitioner so far despite serving the legal notice dated 07.05.2017 (Annexure P-2).

3. The instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.4-Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Jaitu, Faridkot to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her legal notice dated 07.05.2017 and take an appropriate decision within a period of 45 days from the date of receipt

of certified copy of this order and in case of non-disposal of the matter within the stipulated period, it would entail disciplinary action.
